OUR REVISION COURSES

JDD CONSULTANTS have been running patent residential revision courses since 1983. The courses provide intensive tuition specifically geared to examination needs. The courses aim to:

- improve students' knowledge of the law and practice most relevant to the needs of the examination;
- improve students' examination strategies and technique through assessment/counselling on demonstrated performance; and
- provide an environment in which students can improve their knowledge and technique by mutual exchanges of information and experience, informally as well as formally.

The courses are interactive, with break-out sessions to practice and discuss questions. Sizes range typically between 6 and 20 delegates and most of the courses have two tutors to enable close attention to be given to delegates' needs.

The courses for the Foundation Certificate papers have a greater 'imparting key information' element, while the courses for the Final Diploma papers emphasise strategies for tackling each paper. Those attending should have a good knowledge of the law and practice for the course(s) they are attending. Tutors set pre- and post-course work for many of the courses, including submitting or considering answers to certain past questions. We will provide as much notice as possible of pre-course work and provide advice on pre-course study and reading. Course pricing reflects the extent of tutorial work involved in producing/ updating materials and marking scripts.

DEVELOPING OUR COURSES THROUGH FEEDBACK

We develop our courses on the basis of feedback provided by delegates on evaluation forms completed at the end of each course, and discussions with our tutors. We are pleased that delegates gave an 80% (4 out of 5: i.e 'very good' or 'outstanding') rating for the content, presentation and practice of exam questions/technique provided on our most recent courses.

For FC1 we have a new tutoring combination this year: Mark Yeadon and Jack Gunning. For FD1 19H, Sophie Blake and Charlotte Dickerson have, as planned, taken over the course previously tutored by Robbie Berryman and Benedicte Moulin.

For FD4 the 1-day Introduction to FD4 course on 23 May is highly recommended for those taking FD4 for the first time. It provides guidance on how to approach the FD4 paper - reading the question, preparing, structuring and writing an answer - and what work to do ahead of the June, July and August 1.8 day courses. Attendees are then asked to attempt a specified past paper after the course, with tutor feedback later provided on their scripts. This course is best taken in combination with one of the later 1.8 day courses so that most can be got out of the later courses.

Phil Barnes is not tutoring FD4 this year because of work commitments. Etta Collier and Justine Muir, who co-tutor with Chris Mercer, bring to the courses their experiences as current FD4 examiners.

All our face-to-face courses are supported by an online Moodle resources and communication forum. This connects course attendees, with the aim of fostering a 'learning community' which develops pre and post course. The forum also contains a number of resources exclusive to our courses.
