EQE pass rates for GB and Non-GB candidates

From our annual analysis of the EPO's *Statistics on the results of the EQE* <http://www.epo.org/learning-events/eqe/statistics.html> that the pass rates for GB candidates have consistently been higher than those for non-GB candidates.

include compensable fails)

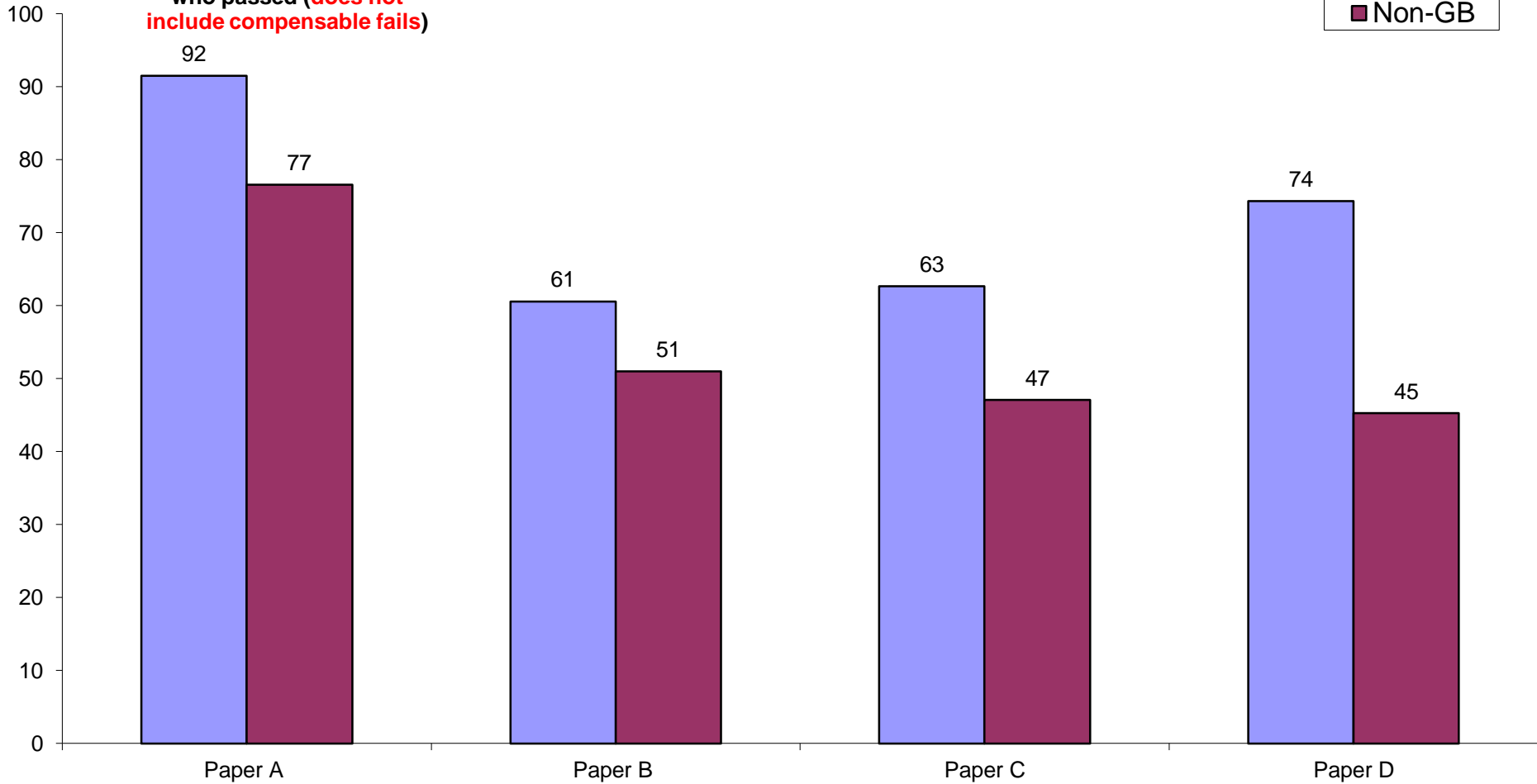


Figure 2: % Pass Rates for GB candidates 2017-19

(excludes compensable fails)

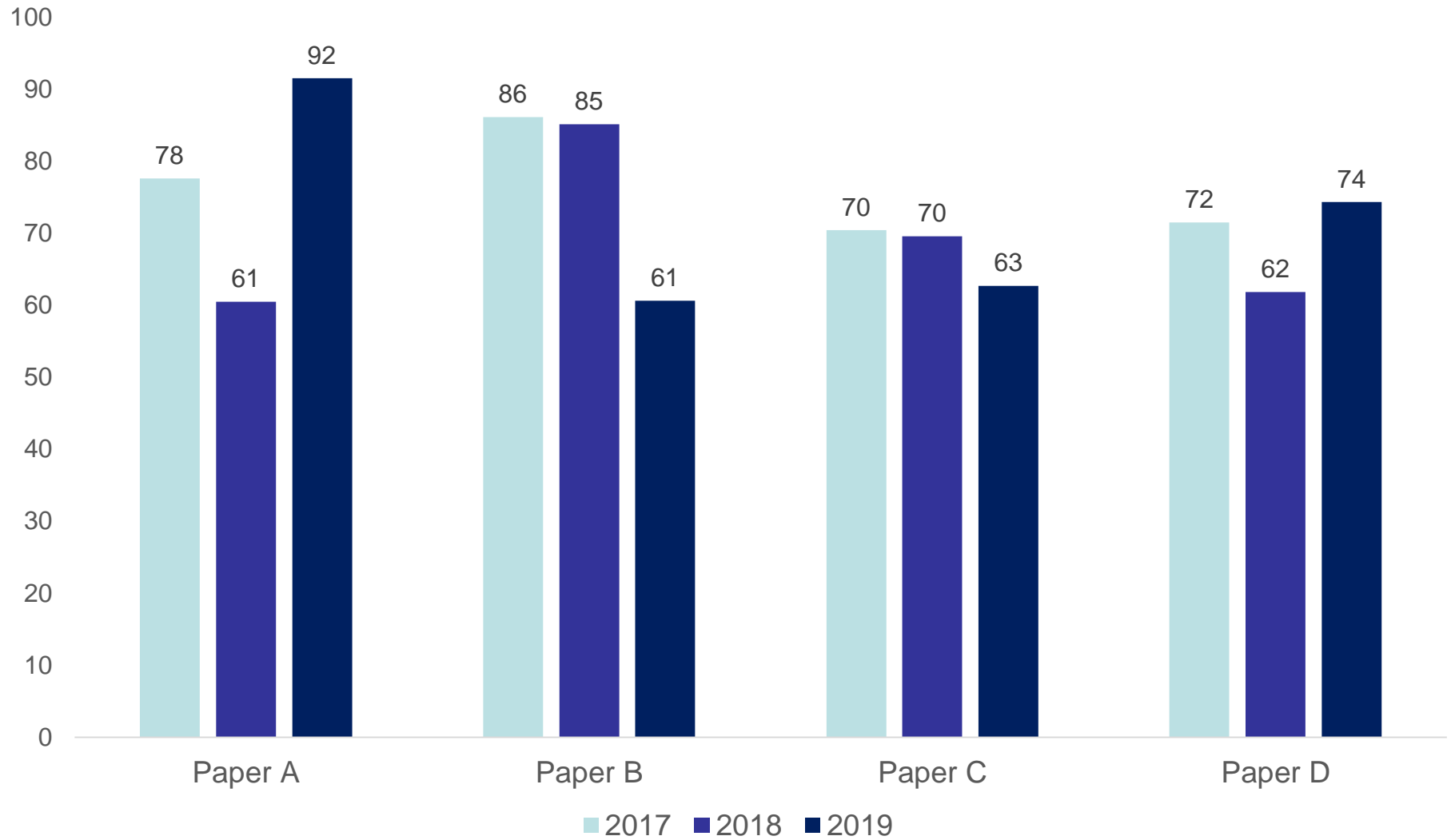


Figure 3: % pass rates in EQE 2019 by candidates from the 5 main countries (this chart does include 'compensable fails')

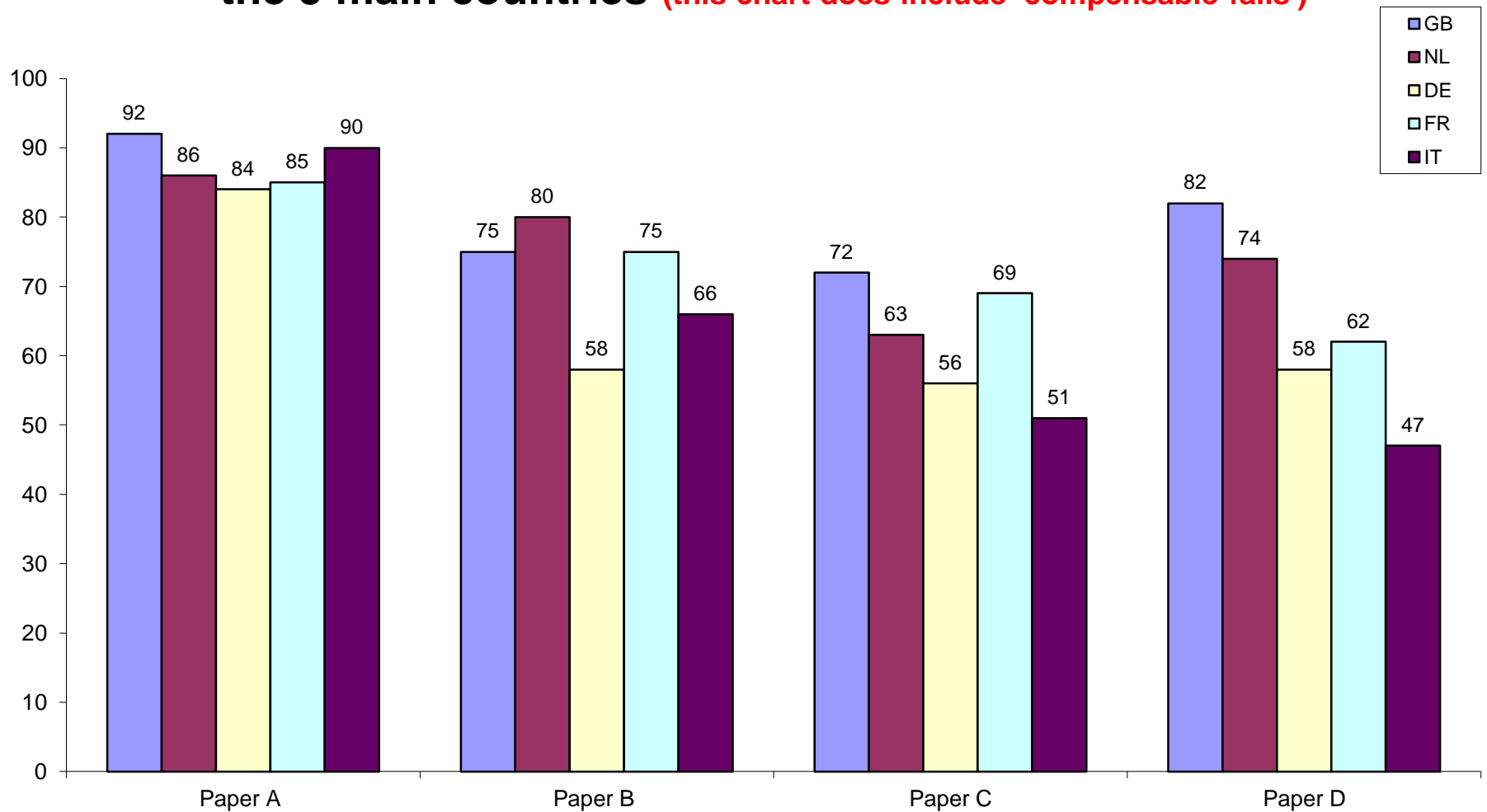


Figure 4: EQE Pre-exam, % of candidates who passed 2014-19
